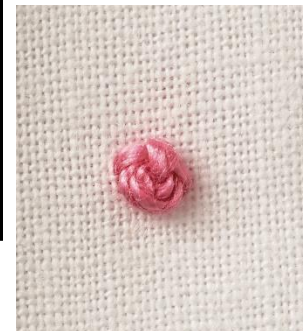
Topic: Sewing - African biomes

DID YOU KNOW?

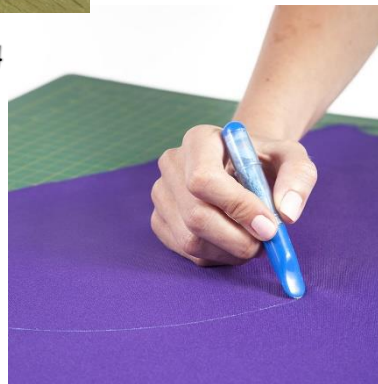
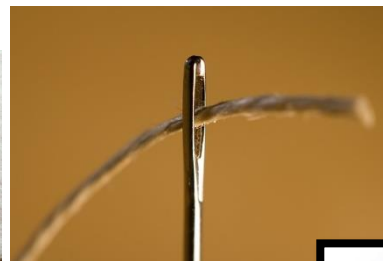
The savanna biome is mostly made up of grass but there are a few trees.

Almost half of Africa is considered a savanna.
