

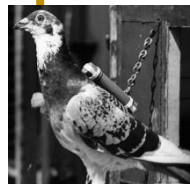
## **Dramatic changes at the start of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century**

### **What were the changing roles for men, women and animals?**

**Key dates:**  
 1901 – Queen Victoria dies & her eldest son becomes King Edward VII  
 1903 – Emmeline Pankhurst created the women's Social and Political Union  
 1910 – King Edward VII dies and his second son becomes King George V  
 1914-1918 World War I  
 1916 – Conscription introduced in Britain  
 1918- Representation of the People Act – votes for women over 30 years with properties  
 1928 – Equal Franchise Act – votes for women over 21 years  
 1930 – The Great Depression  
 1936 – King George V dies
